

Information for Krav-Maga prospective students

Dear prospective student

Thank you for considering taking your Krav-Maga professional qualification with ICS.

If you are:

- ✓ Over 18
- ✓ Have over 3 years of substantial practical experience in Krav-Maga

You might be eligible to participate in our Krav-Maga Practical Instructor's course.

The course is composed of:

1. Registration and video testing assessment. (The video test is valid for 12 months).
2. Completing the online *Krav-Maga instruction methodology course*.
3. Participating in practical 4-8 units' course (4 units for experienced instructors, 8 units for novice and new instructors).

Please read carefully the following guidelines before registering with us. If you have any questions, please contact me directly and we will be happy to assist.

A. How to apply:

1. Register online and pay the 500 NIS **non-refundable** registration fee.
2. Attach a short CV of your martial arts experience in the following format:

You can add any additional information in free text.

If eligible, you will get a written confirmation to continue to prepare your video test. If you don't have at least 3 years of training, with an average of at least 2 hours of Krav-Maga training a week, please do not apply, because you will not be admitted and the registration fee will not be returned. You can check with us for free via email if your training experience is valid as a pre-requisite for entering the Krav-Maga instructor's course.

B. Before taking the video test

1. Both you and your video partner must sign the relevant [waiver forms](#).
2. Email us the signed waiver forms
3. Receive a written confirmation from us stating you may start filming your examination.

Do not film the examination before you got a written confirmation from us.

C. Filming your examination

1. Look at the [entry examination technical form](#).
2. Film all the techniques according to the order they appear in the *entry examination form*.
3. Each technique should be performed and filmed 6 times:
From a front angle: 1st time in real speed and performance, 2nd & 3rd times slowly.
From side or diagonal angle: 1st time in real speed and performance, 2nd & 3rd times slowly.
4. Send us your video.

Following the receiving of your video, we will conduct an evaluation and email you a professional evaluation, and sometimes comments (if required) and our decision.

D. Once accepted

1. Register and complete the online course.
Please note that you can take the online course even if you do not want to take the practical course or if you are not eligible yet to participate in it, we are certain you will gain knowledge from it. Completing the online course will give you precious knowledge and will be accredited to you when you will be admitted to the practical course.
2. Choose a location and date for your practical course and register to it, please note that you will need to supply a [medical approval](#) signed by a Medical Doctor that you are in good health.
